While we cannot guarantee the prices for birth services, as it depends on the specific care your pregnancy and birth may require, **these figures serve as an average estimate.**

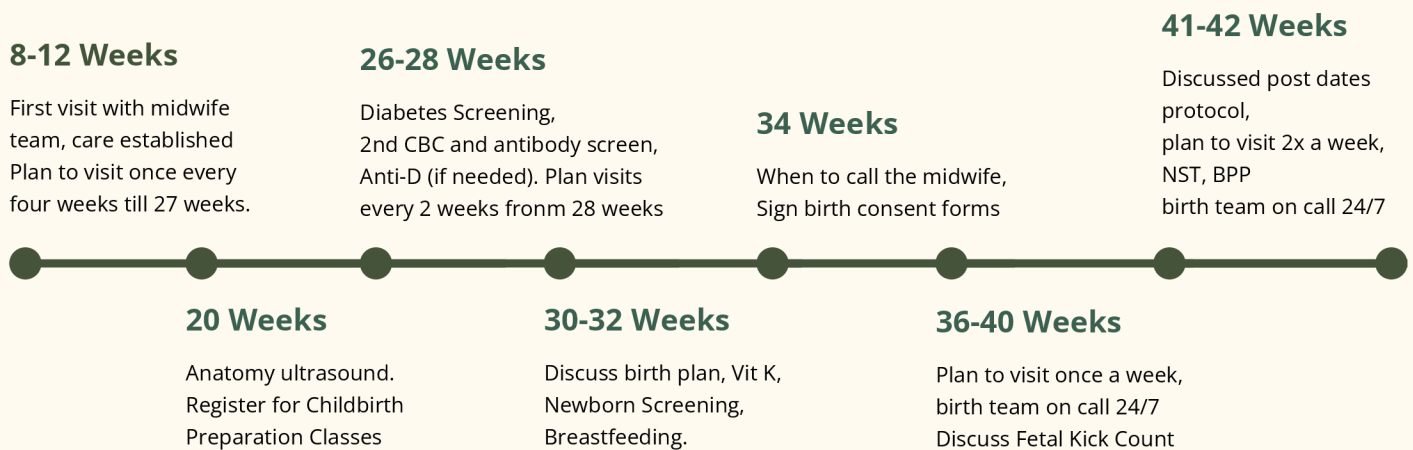
At any point during your care at Madiluu, we support informed consent AND informed refusal of any and all interventions.

MIDWIFERY CONSULTATIONS	<p>One-on-One Time with Your Midwife Care Team Duration: One Hour (plan for 10-18 prenatal consultations)</p> <p>At Madiluu, prenatal consultations are every bit as important as the birth itself. These sessions are designed to build a strong rapport with your midwife care team, ensuring you feel 100% comfortable and safe during labour and birth. Consultation Schedule

During the course of your pregnancy, you'll attend regular prenatal visits, classes, and work with your midwife to prepare your plan for birth. As an active participant in managing your care, you are responsible for attending visits regularly in accordance with the schedule outlined.

GOOD TO KNOW

How many scans do I need?

The only scan recommended for every pregnancy is the 20-week anatomy scan (also known as the anomaly scan, though midwives often prefer a term that reflects normal rather than pathology).

In many hospitals, monthly scans have become the norm. From a midwifery perspective, this practice is excessive and, for most pregnancies, unnecessary.

Do you do scans, labs, and tests at the Centre?

We currently do not offer scans in-house, but most labs and tests can be conveniently done at Madiluu through our partner diagnostic labs.

Complicated Vaginal or Caesarean Birth

At Madiluu, our model of care is designed to support a **normal, natural birth, which typically leads to better long-term outcomes for both mother and baby.** These include **faster recovery times, easier initiation of breastfeeding, and a greater sense of satisfaction for mothers.**

As long as you and your baby remain healthy and low-risk, your care will be provided exclusively by our highly qualified midwifery team. **Our extended, in-depth midwifery consultations and childbirth preparation classes reflect our commitment to thorough education and preparation for a natural birth.**

In **rare cases (10-15%), birth may not go as planned, and medical interventions may be necessary.** To ensure readiness for any situation, Madiluu is equipped with a high-risk obstetric room and a full OT complex for urgent or emergency caesareans. **An anesthesiologist, obstetrician, and OT/NICU nurses will also be available when needed.**
